

Holy Trinity House Expansion Nears Completion



Work will be completed by November 10 on the expansion of the Holy Trinity House at Lutheranch according to Jon Frock, LLMI's Sr. Facilities Consultant. Frock indicated that volunteers have stepped forward to complete much of the project. They have come primarily from Birmingham, AL, and Marietta, GA, but a group has also come on two occasions from as far away as Hickory and Lexington, NC.

When the project is completed, three bedrooms will be added to expand the retreat house to eight bedrooms, which will accommodate 16 adults in lower beds or 27 youth in bunk beds. There will also be a beautiful meeting room on the lower level that overlooks Kingfisher Lake. Retreat groups this fall have eagerly been anticipating the availability of the expanded facilities at the Holy Trinity retreat House, and according to Suzanne Delap, Marketing Assistant, they are already scheduling retreats for the new year.
