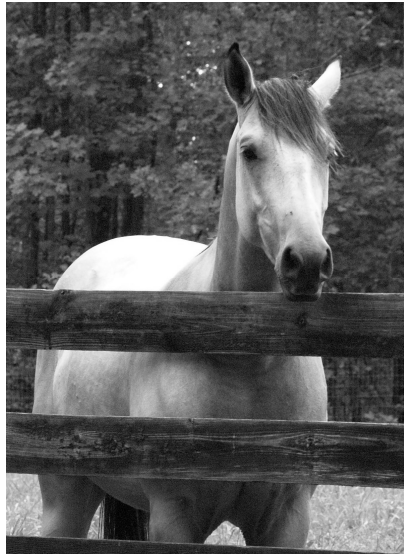


## Lutheranch Sunday

On February 27, 2007, 519 acres was purchased in Tallapoosa, Georgia, that is now known as Lutheranch. This property, purchased by Lutheridge+Lutherock Ministries, features two 12-acre lakes, a creek classified as a Georgia trout stream, wooded acres, and pasture lands. The site also includes a working horse farm and a five-bedroom mini retreat center known as the Holy Trinity House that can sleep 10 adults or 17 youth.



The **Foundations for Faith: The Challenge** campaign is assisting with reducing the mortgage on the \$3.5 million acquisition cost for Lutheranch. Currently a program vision is being finalized and the master site planning is underway. A special need exists to provide funds to operate Lutheranch and the Holy Trinity House in these early years.

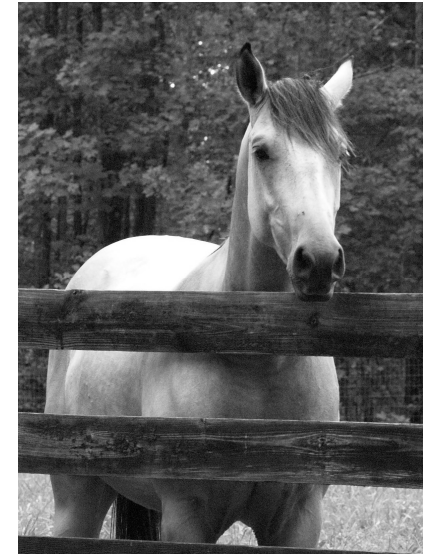
