**CAMP HOURS - DROP OFF/PICK UP**

KinderCamp will run from 9:00-1:00, Monday through Friday.  
Turn in at the Lutheridge gatehouse on HWY 25 (just south of Airport Rd) and follow the signs to the top of the hill near the registration office (EFIRD).  
Continue to follow the signs- the KinderCamp drop off will be clearly marked and staffed.

**HEALTH CARE:** If a camper requires medical attention, it will be given by the licensed nurse in residence at Lutheridge. The nurse will contact a parent or guardian if health care is needed beyond that which can be provided at the Lutheridge infirmary. Each camper must have a signed health history form on file so that emergency treatment may be sought if necessary. Please be sure to fill it out as completely as possible. **Please mail it to our office two weeks prior to KinderCamp!** We **MUST** have the health form before a child can be admitted to KinderCamp.

**MEDICATIONS:** Children may NOT possess any medications, including over the counter medication. If your child must bring medication to camp, please leave it in the original container. The KinderCamp director will ask you to fill out a medication form with specific instructions. The Camp nurse oversees administration of all medications. If over the counter medications are given, that information will be documented and shared with the person picking up the camper that day.

**CAMP ACTIVITIES:** We are going to have SO MUCH FUN! Each day will include games, songs and crafts, organized around a theme for each day. Our themes will explore the ways that we are created and called to share our gifts with others and what it means to be a servant in Jesus' name.
