Dear Scrap Camp 2011 Campers,

I am happy that you are going to be a part of **Scrap Camp** at Lutheridge. As you look over your registration information, if you have questions about registration, lodging, or money, please contact the Registration Office at Lutheridge at the number above. If you have questions about scrapbooking or the activities planned for Scrap Camp you are welcome to drop me an email.

I will be sending you another letter a little closer to the time of Scrap Camp to update you with the details of our time together and a schedule for the retreat.

Scrap Camp is designed to allow you maximum time to work with your own albums and photos. You will share a long table with another scrapper as your individual space for creating. The ends of the tables will be free space for you to store your totes and extra supplies. There is excellent lighting in the crop room and the chairs are comfortable. Digital scrappers will need to bring an extension cord and their own computer. There will be vendors on site and scrapbook stores nearby in case you need additional supplies or expertise.

You can plan to arrive and move into your lodging any time after 3:30PM on Friday, March 6. Just stop by Efird office to pick up your retreat packet...your room key will be inside. At that time, the crop room in the Faith Center will also be open for you to unload your supplies and begin SCRAPPING. Arriving early is a fun way to extend the time you have to get your pages completed in a place where we hope to pamper you with wonderful attention and someone else to do the cooking, cleaning, and whatever while you SCRAP!

Dinner is served at 6 PM Friday in Lineberger Dining Hall. Activities and introductions will officially begin at 7:30 PM in the Faith Center, and we ask that you try to be present at 7:30 if at all possible. If you miss this intro session—you will miss an opportunity to learn more about the others at Scrap Camp and hear about the many opportunities and activities available during our time together. During the retreat we want to protect your time to work on your own photos and pages so please know that all of the other activities are optional. There will be several times of sharing and devotions and you are welcome to continue creating as you listen.

On Sunday, our last meal together will be breakfast at 8:30 AM followed by worship in the Faith Center crop room at 9:30. We ask that you be out of your room by 11:30 AM and then you may continue to crop in the Faith Center throughout the afternoon, if you wish. All linens and towels are provided...that's one washcloth, hand towel and bath towel per person. If you'd like additional towels, please bring them. Toiletries are not provided. Bring layered clothes and rain gear...you never know what the weather will be like at camp. We won't cancel unless I-40 and/or I-26 are closed, which only happens in VERY bad weather. In addition to your scrapping supplies you might want to bring an alarm clock, a flashlight for returning to your room after cropping way into the wee hours of the night, a hair-dryer if you need one (but it's camp, so we love you no matter what you look like!), comfortable walking shoes and of course your camera.

You are invited to plan for a retreat at Scrap Camp that will be relaxing, full of ideas, new friends and a fun time celebrating and sharing our memories in an environment filled with the love of Jesus Christ.
