



Ski LEAPs at Lutheridge

We are glad you will be joining us for the ski LEAP at Lutheridge! Below is some information to frequently asked questions about ski LEAPs. We look forward to having you with us!

HOUSING for the weekend is in Lakeside Village or the Whisnant Youth Village (formerly Wilderness).

Cabins in the Lakeside Village have two bedrooms, each with its own bathroom and two sets of bunk beds with one bottom bed being a double bed. There is a main gathering area with a table, chairs, couch, and kitchenette.

Cabins in the Whisnant Village have one main room holding four sets of single bunk beds. Each cabin has its own bathroom and a separated area with an additional bunk bed, perfect for leaders and chaperones. The bathrooms are equipped with a shower stall, toilet, and sink.

Please note the number of cabins that have been reserved for your group. If you need additional cabins because of your male/female ratio, please contact our offices as soon as possible. If you do not need all your cabins, please let us know as soon as you can so that we may open those cabins to other groups.

SUPERVISION: Group leaders will need to provide overnight supervision for all their participants. The American Camping Association recommends a ration of 6 or 8 youth to 1 adult.

TRANSPORTATION to and from the ski slopes is the responsibility of the group. We will caravan to the slopes, but Lutheridge+Lutherock is unable to provide transportation for all ski LEAP participants.

MEALS: All ski LEAPs, with the exception of the ski LEAP over Martin Lutheran King Weekend; include Saturday breakfast and dinner, and Sunday breakfast. Dinner on Friday is not provided because of the different arrival times of groups. Saturday lunch is up to the group as that is while they are on the ski slopes. We recommend purchasing meal tickets with your ski rentals. The ski LEAP for MLK weekend includes Saturday dinner, Sunday breakfast, Sunday dinner, and Monday breakfast.

SKIING COSTS: You have (or will) been provided with a ski worksheet. The numbers turned in for a group is final. However, we can usually acquire additional tickets and rentals and make general changes up to 3 business days before your arrival. **Lift tickets are non-refundable.** They are printed for that specific date and cannot be transferred to another weekend. If you have a late cancellation and we cannot use the lift ticket for another group that will be attending the same weekend as your group, the cost for the lift ticket will be charged to your group. **Please remember, participants can ski or snowboard, but not both.**

WEATHER POLICY: Lutheridge+Lutherock does not close unless the highway department closes the roads to us. However, because of the difference in elevation, there are times when there is ice on the slopes or the weather has been too warm for snow. In those rare times, we still plan for activities. If skiing is not available, our staff is still ready and waiting for your group to come and experience a LEAP weekend at Lutheridge or Lutherock. While we are happy to move your group to another ski weekend, complete cancellation of the reservation, when activities are still planned for the weekend, will follow our regular cancellation policy.
