Greetings from Lutherock!

I look forward to welcoming you to **FISHERS OF MEN!**, April 9-11, 2010. We will have professional outfitters teaching fly-fishing techniques and leading excursions to the river. We will explore our faith through devotions and worship; taking our time on the river beyond just a catch and release experience.

Please check your confirmation letter to make sure that all information is correct. Feel free to call our Registrar Office at the number listed above. Please encourage others to join us. If you discover that you cannot come for some reason, please call as soon as possible to allow a partial reimbursement of your registration fee.

You are welcome to check into your lodging anytime after 11 AM on Friday, April 9. Your room key will be inside the Crow's Nest for those staying there. Folks in Moretz Lodge will not need a key. We will gather together for the first time at 2PM on Friday to meet with the outfitters learning more about our excursions for the weekend and to learn fishing techniques. Below is the list of things the outfitters say you will need.

Fishing Gear List: 7'-9' 3wt-6wt Fly rod & reel
Waders & Boots
7'-9' Leaders 4x, 5x, and 6x (bring extra tippet in the same sizes)
Flies- Check the FFCO website for hatch report.

You can also rent the following if you don't have this gear already. The cost is \$25 for the rental gear. There is a limited amount of gear available:

Suggested clothing for Fishing Excursion List: Layer Up! April weather in the High Country is unpredictable. It could be sunny and warm, rainy, cold, even snowing! It's best to plan for the worst and hope for the best. Start with a good base layer of long johns and a t-shirt made of wool or a synthetic fabric (polyester, nylon, cape-line, etc...). If you can help it, stay away from cotton fabrics. If you do accidentally go for a swim (hopefully we will all stay dry!) cotton takes forever to dry, and being wet and cold is miserable, not to mention dangerous. Wool also takes time to dry, but the beauty of it is that it still insulates and keeps you warm even when it's wet. Synthetic fabrics lose their insulation properties when they get wet, but they dry quickly. After the base layer, wear a long sleeve shirt, zip neck, or collared shirt. Next put on a fleece or light down, or synthetic fill jacket. Finally, put on a waterproof jacket with a hood. All of these are just examples and suggestions. Oh yeah, as far as pants go, wear whatever you are comfortable in, just keep in mind that fly-fishing is an active sport and wading is like hiking in a mountain stream. You will sweat, you will experience a beautiful piece of God's creation, and you will have a great time fishing!

Finally, you will need a North Carolina Fishing License before the weekend. The website to go to is: <http://www.ncwildlife.org>. It is important that you have this prior to the retreat or you will be unable to actually fish.
